 - d. For those who are discipling/mentoring you?
6. How much time have you spent cultivating intimacy with God this week in:
 - a. Fasting and prayer?
 - b. Daily solitude and weekly Sabbath?
 - c. Worship through singing (alone or corporately)?
7. Have you been absolutely pure and free of even a hint of sexual immorality in thought or action this week? (I Timothy 5:2 & Ephesians 5:3)
8. To what extent have you taken care of your body this week with proper:
 - a. Sleep?
 - b. Exercise?
 - c. Diet?
9. Does your life feel "out of control" in regards to time management, and if so, what are you doing about it?
10. Have you been dishonest, misleading or deceitful in any way this week or in answering these questions?
