Discussion Questions: 2 Kings 6:8-7:2:

1. In this week's passage Elisha prays in verse 17 for the eyes of his servant to be opened to the true reality. What can this teach us when facing life with all its difficulties? (Read Luke 12:4-7) How does this verse balance your perspective on what is important in this life?
2. Why do you think Elisha spared the Arameans in verses 21-23? What message do you think these actions conveyed to the king of Aram? How do you think this shows true strength (meekness)? (Read Romans 12:17-21)
3. What does the eating of one's children say about the level of spiritual depravity that existed in Israel in the time of Elisha? (Read Romans 1:21-32) What does Paul say is the cause of such spiritual depravity?
