List some things we learn about Hezekiah from 2 Chronicles:

*“If we are to have revival in the Lord’s work, we must begin with cleansing. Over the years, individuals and churches can gradually accumulate a great deal of “religious rubbish” while ignoring the essentials of spiritual worship. It’s not by doing some unique new thing that we experience new blessing from the Lord, but by returning to the “old things” and doing them well. If we \_\_\_\_\_ our sins (2 Chronicles 7:14), light the lamps, burn the incense (a picture of prayer, Psalm 141:1–2), and \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves as living sacrifices (v. 7; Romans 12:1–2), the Lord will see and hear and will send His blessing.” (Warren Wiersbe)*
