Discussion Questions: Philippians 2:12-30:

1. In verses 2:14-15 Paul is reflecting on Deuteronomy 32:5. In what ways were the Israelites prevented from being “lights to the world” because of their grumbling and questioning? How might obedient Christians similarly be prevented from being “lights to the world” by their bad attitudes?
2. Paul tells the Philippians that Timothy is uniquely qualified for certain important tasks. Paul also honors Epaphroditus. What caused Paul to esteem these two individuals? What about your life would cause those who are in your life to conclude that your love for Jesus and concern for others was genuine?
3. What do you think the balance is between, (1) critical thinking and reflection, and (2) grumbling and complaining?
