Gnostics...

- Didn't believe that Jesus really became a \_\_\_\_\_ and lived among us.
- Claimed to have \_\_\_\_\_ special knowledge about spirituality and separated themselves from the church.
- Didn't act like Christ (especially in the loving others department).
- Didn't think they had a \_\_\_\_\_ problem.

Those who walk in the light...

- Know that Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ to come.
- Have fellowship with one another.
- Are growing to look more and more like Christ (especially in the \_\_\_\_\_ department).
- Still humbly \_\_\_\_\_ their need for grace and forgiveness (even though they are growing).

What does it mean that God is light?

What does walking in the darkness mean?

Why do we still need the blood of Jesus if we are "*walking in the light*"?

(Isaiah 6:5, Luke 5:8, 1 Timothy 1:15)
