**Discussion Questions: John 10:1-21:**

1. Reflect on Jesus' metaphor of sheep and shepherds. Who are the robbers, who are the sheep and who is the shepherd? What is so offensive to those listening about Jesus' characterizations?
2. Jesus confronts the people listening to Him with this truth: the sheep willfully, gladly follow the true shepherd. On a scale, with 1 being that someone is dragging you, and 10 being that you gladly follow the Shepherd's voice, what number are you? Are there things that you do that you separate from your life of following Jesus? What are they? What are you seeking in them that you do not want Jesus to interfere with you?
3. Do you practice Jesus' presence? What specific things do you practice and why those specific things? How can the people in a small group help each other practice the presence of Jesus individually and as a group?
4. Read Psalm 23 and discuss how this Psalm relates to John chapter 10.
