

**Sermon Notes for August 6, 2017**  
**John 19:25-42: It Is Finished!**

In the midst of His own pain and suffering, Jesus cared for others.

What is finished? This is a defining moment.

Verses 31-37: Pierced but not \_\_\_\_\_ (*Deut. 21:22-23*).

There were two prophecies involved:

- *Psalm 34:20* (“He protects all His bones, not \_\_\_\_\_ of them will be broken.”)
- *Zechariah 12:10* (“They will look on Me, the One whom they have \_\_\_\_\_.”)

*“That our Lord’s bones should remain unbroken, and yet that He should be pierced, seemed a very unlikely thing; but it was carried out. When next you meet with an \_\_\_\_\_ promise, believe it firmly. When next you see things working contrary to the truth of God, believe \_\_\_\_\_, and believe nothing else. Let God be true and every man a liar. Though men and devils should give God the lie, hold you on to what God has spoken; for heaven and earth shall pass away, but not one jot or tittle of his word shall fall to the ground.” (Charles Spurgeon)*

Verses 38-42: With the \_\_\_\_\_ in His death.
