Discussion Questions: Revelation 5:1-10:

1. What do you think about no person in heaven on earth, or under the earth being able to open the scroll with its seven seals? Why do you think John was so distressed when no one was found worthy to execute what was in the scroll?
2. How was Jesus counted worthy to break the seals and open the scroll? Was it in his strength or in his surrender? How should we as believers respond to this as we overcome as mentioned in previous chapters?
3. One day every knee will bow, and every tongue will confess Jesus as Lord; one will bow in adoration and the other will bow (cower) in fear. What role do you think worship plays in this choice? Is worship just about singing a “new song” or does it have more to do with surrender, trust and obedience?
