**Genesis 10: Hope For All The Nations**

*The sons of Noah who came out of the ark were Shem, Ham and Japheth. (Ham was the father of Canaan.) These were the \_\_\_\_\_ sons of Noah, and from them came the people who were scattered over the whole \_\_\_\_\_. (Genesis 9:18-19)*

*Therefore go and make disciples of all \_\_\_\_\_, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...  
(Matthew 28:19)*

*So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian (**descendant of** \_\_\_\_\_)... “Look, here is water. What can stand in the way of my being baptized?” (Acts 8)*

*Placing his hands on Saul (**descendant of** \_\_\_\_\_), he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul’s eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized... (Acts 9)*

*At Caesarea there was a man named Cornelius, a centurion in what was known as the Italian Regiment (**descendant of** \_\_\_\_\_). Then Peter said, “Surely no one can stand in the way of their being baptized with water...”*
